State

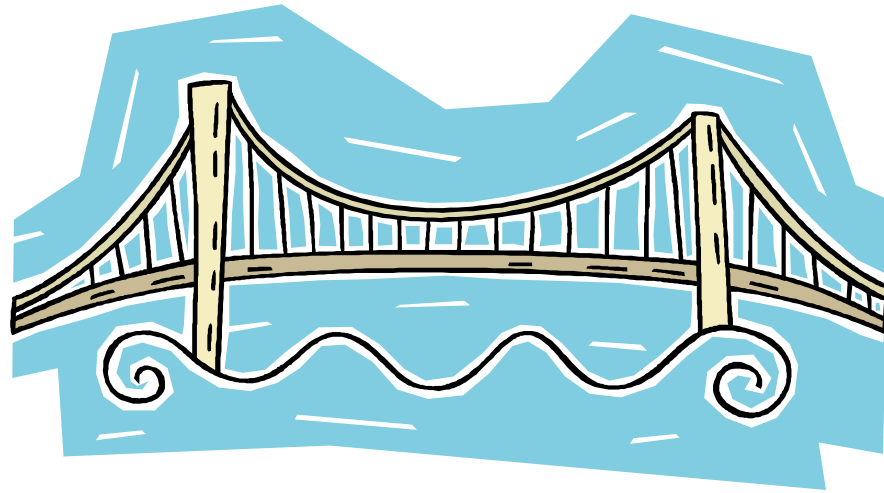
- Hold administration to GWSA goals/milestones

 - Administration will need prompting for fall action
