All Saints Parish is the first congregation in the Commonwealth of Massachusetts to purchase 100% Green-e certified electricity from renewable resources for all of its facilities. In addition to purchasing Green-e certified electricity, All Saints Parish has undertaken an aggressive energy stewardship campaign based on conservation and efficiency that is expected to save the church thousands of dollars a year on its utility bills. A little more than a tenth (10%) of this savings was applied to cover the costs of green electricity. The result is that All Saints Parish is reducing its greenhouse gas emissions by more than fifty percent. Thank you for setting a powerful example of environmental stewardship for the community of faith.
