with our "Energy Conservation Stewardship" Award. St. Paul's Church was recently awarded an Energy Star for Congregations Award (a program of the Environmental Protection Agency) for its recent implementation of energy-efficient improvements. Among energy upgrades, St. Paul's Church added programmable thermostats, upgraded ballasts, added thermopane windows, added new fluorescent fixtures, and installed compact fluorescent lamps (CFLs). St. Paul's also added outdoor lights with timers, added light sensors in the parking area, and installed timers on bathroom lights. St. Paul's Church converted its heat from oil to (cleaner burning) natural gas with a new, highly efficient boiler. St. Paul's Church is preventing about 273,000 pounds of CO2 from being released into the atmosphere – all while saving money on utility bills. Thank you for setting a powerful example of environmental stewardship for the community of faith.
