The International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers Local 103, based in Dorchester, has shown its willingness and ability to adapt toward a clean, renewable electricity future. In the Fall of 2002, Local 103 installed a 5.4 k/W Solar System on the roof of their Apprenticeship Training Facility. Today Local 103 installs solar energy throughout Eastern Massachusetts. In 2005, Local 103 continued to be at the cutting edge of their industry when they installed a 100 k/W Wind Turbine on their property. This is Boston’s first commercial scale wind turbine, and, like the solar panels, the Wind Turbine has a high visibility presence just off the Expressway. In addition to reducing electricity costs, Local 103 will use the turbine to train its members to install turbines. Thank you for your environmental stewardship and industry leadership.
