with our “Clean Energy Vision” Award. Cape Wind is proposing America’s first offshore wind farm on Horseshoe Shoal in Nantucket Sound. When completed, 130 wind turbines located miles from the nearest shore would gracefully harness the wind to produce up to 420 megawatts of clean, renewable energy. In average winds, Cape Wind would provide three quarters of the Cape and Island’ electricity needs. Cape Wind would establish Massachusetts as a world-wide leader in offshore renewable energy technology. Cape Wind would create up to a thousand jobs in manufacturing, assembly, and ocean construction, boosting the local economy and creating 150 permanent jobs thereafter, including 50 highly paid maintenance and operations jobs. Cape Wind would also help reduce energy costs by providing Cape and Island residents a way to stabilize their electricity prices through fixed priced electricity contracts.
