with our “Energy Efficiency” Award. NSTAR Electric and Gas, which serves 1.4 million customers in Boston and surrounding communities, has a long history of outstanding energy efficiency programs and participation with communities of faith. The Roman Catholic Archdiocese of Boston has taken the lead in participation in NSTAR’s efficiency programs. Starting in 2005, the Archdiocese worked with NSTAR to educate all of its parishes about NSTAR’s energy efficiency program opportunities. Since then, NSTAR has completed 72 projects at about 50 different parishes. The total cost of the projects is \$318,000; NSTAR has contributed \$254,000 in financial incentives toward that cost; and the Archdiocese should save over 400,000 kilowatt hours and 330 kilowatts annually. Additionally, seven congregations of various denominations participated in NSTAR’s programs in 2005, saving 89,000 kWh annually combined. These savings not only benefit the congregations directly, but they also help the environment.
