Included in these are completely replacing all light bulbs in the school with energy efficient bulbs, building a retention pond adjacent to a new parking lot, and cleaning the pond drains regularly to prevent pollutants from escaping into the Spicket River, annual cleanup projects of the Spicket River, involving both students and faculty, installing weather-resistant plexiglass on all stained glass windows in the school chapel, the use of "virtual dissection in Biology labs to avoid needless killing of animals, the use of micro scales in Chemistry labs to avoid chemical spillage into the waste water system. Students and faculty are working together to develop the course curriculum for an Environmentalism class. Thank you for your environmental stewardship.
