Founded in 2003, we currently have 250 member congregations. We are a state chapter of the national Interfaith Power & Light network with affiliate organizations in 39 other states.

The mission of Massachusetts Interfaith Power & Light involves:

- Educating people on why climate change is a matter of morality and justice.
- Fostering public understanding of policies that will lead to a sustainable future.
- Working with faith communities and their members to be better environmental stewards of their buildings by providing technical expertise and assessing ways they can lower their carbon emissions and save money.

We seek a new leader with outstanding organizing and public outreach skills who can help us advance our mission to inspire congregations and individuals to live faithfully and sustainably here in the 21st century, and respond by taking proactive steps locally and regionally.

This 20-25 hour/week position involves:

- Serving as a public voice and community presence around our state and in our religious communities.
- Working with our member congregations and coalitions to advocate for sustainable policy at the regional and state level.
- Working with our Board to develop our vision and implement our programs.
- Working with our Board to develop and implement a fundraising plan including mailings to members, identifying sources of grant funding, and writing grant proposals
- Managing our organizational administration.

We are looking for someone who has excellent knowledge of faith issues and environmental policy and is excited by a vision of people living more lightly and decently on this fragile and beautiful planet.

Salary range: \$22-27/hour, depending on experience.
